

#### 2023/2024 Budget

- The Anacortes School District needs to proactively balance the budget for the 2023-2024 school year and beyond
- \$2,600,000 Initial items reflecting this impact:
  - Expenditures are exceeding state and federal revenue
  - Enrollment continues to decline
  - Federal relief grants will be fully expended
    - There is no indication for future Federal relief
- Updated items increasing estimate to \$3,200,000 to \$3,700,000
  - Collective Bargaining Agreements Negotiations
  - Inflation Cost of goods and services have increased
  - Legislative session impact

### 2023/2024 Budget Status

Projected changes to budget for 2023/2024	Impact
Original Projected Deficit	(\$2,600,000)
Enrollment is up for 22/23 impacting projections for 23/24	\$500,000
Insurance increase estimate at 24%	(\$134,000)
Projected cost of living (3.7%) and estimated labor relations impacts	(\$753,423)
Reductions made in 22/23 that carryover to 23/24	\$586,189
Reductions made for 23/24	\$638,571
Reductions in process (estimated amount)	\$1,246,284
Legislation - Experience Factor 4% (unknown factor)	\$580,000
Current Net Projected Change	\$63,621

# District Office Reductions Made in 2022/2023 impact for 2023/2024

- Reductions made in 2022/2023 in the amount of \$586,189
  - 3 Technology Support Specialists
  - 2 District Office Administrative Assistants
  - Reduce contract days for Technology Integration Coordinator

#### Reductions made for 2023/2024

- District office reductions made for the 2023/2024 school year in the amount of \$378,862
  - 1 District Office Administrator
  - 1 District Office Administrative Assistant
  - Reduce contract days for District Office Administrator
  - MSOCS: Pride, WASA/AWSP Conference, WSSDA Conference


#### Reductions made for 2023/2024

- Other reductions made for the 2023/2024 school year in the amount of \$259,709
  - Custodial/Grounds
  - Transportation Dispatcher/Trainer
  - Birth to 3 Program

### In Process Reductions pending for 2023/2024

- Pending reductions for the 2023/2024 school year in the amount of \$1,246,284
  - Certificated staff
  - Classified staff including Para-professionals
  - Athletics/Co-Curricular/Clubs

### 88% of the Budget is Staff
